- Name practise
- Patterns in the sand using fingers
- Making faces using stones / shells / Mr Potato head pieces

Water

- Washing the dolls
- Washing up - pots and pans
- Pouring and emptying

- Head, shoulders, knees and toes
- Tommy thumb

Maths

- Identifying numbers in the environment
- Number hunt
- Sorting colours into groups
