Geography/History

We will be continue to compare Chesterfield with Mexico. Focusing on Chesterfield to start and flying on to Mexico City.

We will be talking about human and physical features of localities.

We will be looking at culture and sampling Mexican food and dance.

Both the Year 1 and 2 children will be using all their knowledge and skills at the end of the term to complete a final independent piece of writing based on the book, 'Owl and the Pussy Cat.'
