Me, My House and Getting Around

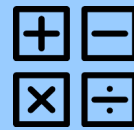
- Exploring the local area

Maths

This term we are looking at ;

- place value within 10.
- Number and subtraction within 10,
- Geometry—2d and 3d shapes
- Place value within 20



Life skills

Using the PHSE Matters curriculum we will be Exploring Emotions in Autumn 1. We will be naming emotions and considering how they affect

how we think, feel and behave.

Theme: Health and Wellbeing: H11, H12, H13, H14, H15, H16, H17, H18, H19

H11. Naming different feelings.
H12. Explaining how to recognise different feelings.
H13. Recognising that feelings can affect the way we think, feel and behave.
H14. Talking about how to recognise what others might be feeling.
H15. Recognising that not everyone feels the same about the same things.
H16. Naming a range of words to describe feelings.
H17. Talking about things that help people's mental/physical health.
H18. Identifying ways to manage big feelings.
H19. Recognising when they need help and understand how to ask for help.

Theme: Relationships: R8, R9, R10, R11, R12, R20, R21, R22, R24

R8. Recognising simple strategies to resolve arguments between friends positively.
R9. Recognising how to ask for help if a friendship is making them feel unhappy.
R10. Recognising that bodies/feelings can be hurt by words and actions.
R11. Identifying how people may feel if they experience hurtful behaviour or bullying.
R12. Understanding that hurtful behaviour is not acceptable.
R12. Explaining how to report bullying and the importance of telling a trusted adult.
R20. Identifying what to do if they feel worried.
R21. Identifying what is kind and unkind behaviour.
R22. Recognising how to treat themselves and others with respect.
R24. Playing, listening and working cooperatively.

In Autumn 2 we will look at Bullying Matters. Covering resolving disagreements and recognising how to treat themselves and other with respect.

Monster Phonics

Our adventures in Monster Phonics Land will continue as we revise and consolidate our learning in Reception and build upon these foundations. Daily Phonics lessons will continue alongside our Guided Reading sessions.



Drawing Club

During Year 1 we will continue our exciting Drawing Club Adventures.

We will be exploring new and exciting texts and animations.

When doing our Drawing Club we are also exposed to some very adventurous vocabulary which we will begin to mag-pie and adopt into our own written codes to ensure the magic works.

We will continue to work on our handwriting ensuring to apply this in our writing. Close attention will be brought to spelling, grammar and punctuation work. We will continue to battle those finger spaces, capital letters, full stops and question marks. Children will also be encouraged to lengthen their sentences and combine ideas using 'and'.

Physical Education

In our PE lessons, we will be focusing on developing a range of basic skills this term. This will include learning and developing our orienteering skills

We will also be doing dance where we will be listening and exploring movement. Exploring movements imaginatively to express emotion. We will be performing simple dance routines.



Religious Education

During our Religious Education lessons, we will be exploring the big question—Who is a Christian and what do they believe?

In Autumn 2 we will look at the Christmas story and how Christians prepare for this important celebration.

Music

We will be using the Charanga music scheme of work to develop our music skills.

This term we will begin a unit based on Rhythm and singing which will run throughout the year.



Geography

In our Geography lessons we will be studying the geography of the school and the school grounds. We will also look at key human and physical features of our surrounding environment. To do this we will use simple maps, compass directions and directional language to describe the locational features.



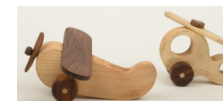
Homework

On Friday we will send home the sound we have been focusing on and some examples of words we have looked at for you to review at home with your child. Please try to read the Monster Phonics ebook/book 3 times a week and continue to share other books including non-fiction (recipes, instructions, fact books) with your child.

We'd like the children to practise counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 before moving on to learning their x2 x5 x10 tables at home. There are games to support this learning on Purple Mash.

The multi intelligence homework grid will be sent home, please choose a SMART to return to school for our topic showcase at the end of this term (dates and times to follow).

Design and Technology



In our Design and Technology lessons in Autumn 2, we will explore different toys with wheels. The children will then be given the opportunity to design and make their own toy with wheels, by exploring and using mechanisms, such as axles and wheels first.

Science



As super scientists we will be exploring the processes involved in our Cosmic Castle approach to working scientifically. This will then be built upon throughout the year to underpin all our science work to promote and ensure we are able to work scientifically using simple equipment and gathering and recording data.

We will then go on to explore animals including humans. We will be identifying, naming and drawing the basic parts of the human body. We will be identifying and classifying animals as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

History

In our History lessons in Autumn 2, we will be learning about the development of early flight. We will study the lives of the Wright Brothers and how their achievements changed the world and continue to impact on us all.



Art

Our art activities this term will involve us exploring mark making using ink, charcoal, chalks and pencils.

We will be exploring how different marks can tell a story and show different emotions. We will look at the artist Odilia Fu and their use of mark making in their pieces of art.



Computing

We will be looking closely at online safety, grouping and sorting and pictograms.

Our learning is all based on Purple Mash—which gives the children opportunities to continue their learning at home using their logins.
