## **WELLCOMM**

WellComm is a speech and language toolkit that can be used with children from 6 months to 6 years of age. It is a means of tracking progress of all children and will identify areas of concern in language, communication and interaction.

## Monster Phonics (Post Y1 check)

During daily 15 minute sessions, children with specific learning difficulties use this structured programme to improve their phonics and reading skills.
